This season of prayer and fasting will be aided and accompanied by several tools in this document, including a Biblical guide to fasting, different fasting options, and a prayer guide for each of the 14 days that includes Biblical passages and a prayer.

When participating in a corporate prayer and fasting, many Christians and Churches have found that God meets with us in very unique and special ways. His presence grows greater and greater with each day of the fast. Without fail, He always shows up! And is faithful to meet our needs during times of prayer!

When you fast and pray, you will see amazing results from God. You will see godly changes in your home/family, prayers answered in incredible ways, wisdom gained about hard issues, and in it all, you will mostly appreciate that your own desires become secondary to God's. It's all about putting Him first, and letting our Shepherd lead the way all year long. Without a doubt, fasting sets you on a great course every year. Ps 37:23 says, "The steps of a man are established by the LORD, And He delights in his way" (nasb),

What is fasting?

To fast "means primarily "not to eat." Biblical fasting always centers on spiritual purposes. Fasting typically involves abstaining from all food, solid or liquid, but not water, for a determined amount of time with specific spiritual goals. A thorough definition might be: "the fast is an act of the will through which the individual Christian exerts spiritual control over the flesh (through not eating, or through the laying down of other distractions and hindrances) with a view to a more personal and powerful experience with God in prayer. "it involves giving up the physical to attain the more significant spiritual insights.

WHY FAST?

Fasting is a spiritual tool God uses to advance his kingdom, change nations' destiny, spark a revival, and bring victory in people's lives. Life Changers will begin the year with a season of prayer and fasting! We will humble ourselves before God and consecrate ourselves, seeking for direction and instructions for the upcoming year.

Christ gave us an example!

Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And after fasting forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. MATTHEW 4:1–2

And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and a report about him went out through all the surrounding country. LUKE 4:14

Jesus knew he was going to need spiritual strength to fulfill his purposes. Fasting makes us spiritually healthy and prepares us to do God's work.

PLANNING YOUR FAST

Then Joshua said to the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." JOSHUA 3:5

Pray—Spend time in the presence of the Lord. Indulge yourself in the reading of the Bible before the fast. Ask the Holy Spirit for guidance in your prayers. Pages will be provided in this guide for you to write down your faith goals and specific prayer requests for your family, friends, church, and nation.

Commit—Seek the face of God concerning the type of fast the Spirit will have you to undertake. After this time of prayer, commit to your plans and ask God to give you the grace to follow through with this commitment.

Act— During this fast, avoid food high in sugar and fat—plan to limit physical and social activities during your fast time. Ask someone to be your accountability partner throughout the fast.

Don't be legalistic. Be sensible. You may choose in the course of the fast, to intensify your effort—to move to a more rigorous schedule; or you may need to lace into your fast some grace! Remember, the goal is not fasting – it is a deeper encounter with God, and that is always by grace. Fasting is the discipline we impose on ourselves to 'present ourselves a living sacrifice' that draws the fire of God, to break the world's grip, and offer ourselves to God.

WHILE FASTING

[Jesus] answered, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" MATTHEW 4:4

Focus – It is essential that you set aside quality time for the Word of God! Be ready to respond to God's Word and the Holy Spirit's leading as you are enlightened during this time of fasting and consecration.

Pray—Be sure to join us for one of the daily prayer call opportunities during this consecration. Please intercede for your family, church, pastors, nation, and missions throughout the consecration during this time.

Replenish—During mealtime, read the Bible and pray. Drink plenty of water and rest as much as you can. Be ready for temporary bouts of physical weakness and mental annoyances like impatience and irritability.

Which scriptures support fasting?

Fasting has solid scriptural roots. Here are several examples of fasting:

In Joel's book, God called His people to fast and pray for a time of repentance, personal commitment, and revival among the people.

The people of God faced national extinction in the days of Esther, the queen. Esther called for her people to respond with a fast in Esther 4:16. God called His people to pray and fast during a significant crisis, and God delivered His people.

Ezra proclaimed a fast for protection as the people returned to the land following the walls' rebuilding. God heard, and He answered by giving them supernatural protection (Ezra 8:21).

When Daniel was faced with spiritual battles, he fasted and prayed: "in those days, I, Daniel, was mourning three full weeks. I ate no pleasant food, no meat or wine came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled," (Daniel 10:1–2).

Joel called a national fast at the beginning of a locust plague. "consecrate a fast, call a sacred assembly; gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of the Lord your God, and cry out to the Lord," (Joel 1:14). We may never see a plague of locust, but we are seeing a plague of unrighteousness. Abortion, pornography, violence, terrorism and lawlessness show the rebellion of the people against God's Word.

What are the results of fasting?

Fasting allows us to experience God through a more intense and productive prayer life. This is true of the individual and the church. The fast will have no purpose if seen as only an interlude in an otherwise worldly-centered lifestyle. It must be a step toward a deeper commitment to know God and His will for our lives.

Fasting results in our being more attentive to God and the things of God.

Fasting results in our being more aware of our inadequacies and His adequacy.

Fasting results in believers being changed in ways so they are empowered to change the world!

Fasting results in God moving powerfully in our lives and in the church in ways that allow Him to show Himself to this generation.

TYPES OF FASTS

Complete Fast

- Drinking only liquids, typically water and/or light juices.
- Broth or soup may be included as options.

Selective Fast

- Removing certain elements from your diet.
- The Daniel Fast - abstaining from meat, sweets, or bread; drink water and juice, and eat a variety of fruits and vegetables.

Partial Fast (a.k.a. The Jewish Fast)

- Abstaining from eating any type of food in the morning and afternoon.
- Fast during specific times of the day, e.g. 6AM-3PM, or from sunup to sundown.

Soul Fast

- Common for: anyone new to fasting food; those with health issues that prevent them from fasting food; those wanting to refocus specific areas of life that are out of balance.
- Suggestions: abstain from engaging in social media, shopping, watching television, etc.

SAMPLE MENU 1: FRUITS, VEGETABLES, JUICES & WATER

Breakfast - Fruit smoothie with protein powder

Mid-morning Snack - Fresh fruit or fresh vegetables

Lunch - Raw vegetable salad with light dressing and vegetable broth soup

Mid-afternoon Snack - Fresh fruit or fresh vegetables

Dinner - Fresh salad with light dressing and steamed grilled vegetables

SAMPLE MENU 2: LIQUIDS ONLY

Breakfast - Fruit smoothie with protein

Mid-morning Snack - Herbal tea or vegetable broth soup

Lunch - Raw juiced vegetables

Mid-afternoon Snack - Fresh fruit juice or fruit smoothie with protein

Dinner - Vegetable juice or vegetable broth soup

SAMPLE MENU 3: MODIFIED DANIEL FAST

Breakfast - 1 - 2 servings whole grains with fresh fruit juice

Mid-morning Snack - Fresh fruit or fresh chopped vegetables

Lunch - 1 - 2 servings whole grains; fresh salad with legumes and light dressing

Mid-afternoon Snack - Fresh fruit juice or fruit smoothie with protein

Dinner - 1 - 2 whole grains; fresh salad with legumes and light dressing

Concentrate on The Word of God

- Once you have begun your fast, don't spend all your time in front of the television. Too many foods are advertised on television. The most important reason not to watch a lot of television, however, is that television won't feed your soul (or your spirit).
- Don't waste your time on magazines or other frivolous reading materials either. Use this opportunity to get into the Word of God. Meditate on God's promises. Let your mind dwell on them. Claim them for yourself.
- The Word of God is so powerful that it can penetrate any obstacle, any circumstance, or any problem in life. It is more powerful than a two-edged sword. It can separate the spirit from the soul. It can slice into the thoughts and intents of the heart. (See Hebrews 4:12- 14)

Don't Neglect the Prayer Aspect of Fasting

- Our principal purpose in prayer is not to wrestle with the Enemy. If you allow him to, Satan will dominate your prayer time. The purpose of prayer is to communicate with the Father, to tell Him of our love, to worship and adore Him, and to intercede before Him for others.
- Don't pray for the Devil to go. Command him to go. Use the authority God has given you. Put the Enemy in his place. Let him know that he has no right to disturb you while you are communing with the Father.
- Don't hesitate to bind any evil spirit that torments you during prayer and fasting. Don't ask God to take care of them. He has given you authority to take care of them. Don't be afraid. Speak directly to the demons. Bind them in Jesus' name. Command them to take their hands off of your family, off of your business, and off of your house.

Day 1, January 11: to increase in spiritual hunger and holiness

Psalm 51:10-12: Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of my salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

Daniel 6:10: Now when Daniel learned that the decree had been published, he went home to his upstairs room where the windows opened toward Jerusalem. Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before.

Prayer:

Lord, awaken my heart to Your love. Give me an increased hunger to spend more time in prayer, worship, and Your Word. Please give me a greater awareness of Your holiness, a tender conscience, and a heart to please You in every thought, word, and deed.

Day 2, January 12: to experience revival

Psalm 86:6: Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?

Psalm 80:18-19: Then we will not turn away from you; revive us, and we will call on your name. Restore us, Lord God Almighty; make your face shine on us, that we may be saved.
2 Chronicles 7:14: If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

Prayer:

Father, I pray for a marketplace revival to sweep through our community and for revival to break out in Your streets, in schools, government, business, media, entertainment, and congregations – especially in Your congregations as we are reflecting who You are. I ask, Lord, that You raise up dedicated Christians who will become a voice to reform our region and to make a difference in the lives of all who live here.

Day 3, January 13: to receive a fresh outpouring of God's Spirit

Psalm 51:2: Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.

Psalm 51:7: Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.

Mark 2:22b: But new wine must be put into new wine skins.

Prayer:

Lord, I pray for times of refreshing as Your Word and Holy Spirit's presence cleanse and renew me. I pray that I will be spiritually-minded and that I will say yes to Your way and will through me. Thank you for Your faithfulness to me! I pray that my spiritual family will receive a fresh outpouring of Your Spirit!

Day 4: January 14: to be saved and delivered

Psalm 18:2: The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

Psalm 16:11: You make known to me the path of life; You will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.

Acts 16:31 (AMP): Believe in and on the Lord Jesus Christ—that is, give yourself up to Him, take yourself out of your own keeping and entrust yourself into His keeping, and you will be saved; [and this applies both to] you and your household as well

Prayer:

Father, I pray for the hurting and lost of this world. I ask that You do what only You can in the life of _____ (insert name). Be their Rock, their Redeemer. Use me in effective ways to show Your love. Enter into the hearts of those far from You. Be their Savior; deliver them into a transforming relationship with You. I pray for any loved ones by name who do not know the Lord or have fallen away from You. I ask You to reveal Yourself to them as the awesome God that You are. I pray a hedge of protection around

my family from all deception, temptation, and any plans of the enemy that would thwart the good plans God has for them.

Day 5, January 15: to produce the fruit of the Spirit

Galatians 5:22: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

1 Corinthians 13:4: Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.

Prayer:

Gracious God, thank You for Your Word that describes so clearly what love is and for Your Son Jesus who humbly modeled it on earth for us. Help my family and I to produce the Fruit of Your Spirit and love each other in a way that pleases You. May we always have a love that protects, trusts, hopes, and perseveres.

Day 6, January 16: to find and fulfill your destiny

Psalms 139:24b: ...lead me in the way everlasting.

Psalms 18:36: You provide a broad path for my feet, so that my ankles do not give way.

Psalms 37:23: The Lord makes firm the steps of the one who delights in him.

Psalms 44:18: Our hearts had not turned back; our feet had not strayed from your path.

Prayer:

Lord, please give me the next step in Your Divine plan for my life. Help me to be still and know that You are God, so that I can clearly sense Your guidance and hear from You. I commit to follow You, forever.

Day 7, January 17: to be filled with power and purpose

Psalms 61:3 & 5: For you have been my refuge, a strong tower against the foe. For you, God, have heard my vows; you have given me the heritage of those who fear your name.

Psalms 92:11: My eyes have seen the defeat of my adversaries; my ears have heard the rout of my wicked foes.

Romans 15:13: May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer:

Father God, I pray for You to help me stay connected to the Vine. Lord, I desire You in every aspect of my life. Please prune off the things that are not important and get in the way of my time with You. I know that I can only fulfill your purpose for me by being filled with Your Holy Spirit.

Day 8, January 18: to walk in wisdom and revelation

Psalm 43:3: Send me your light and your faithful care, let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy mountain, to the place where you dwell.

Ephesians 1:17-18: I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and the incomparably great power for us who believe.

Prayer:

Lord, open my eyes to see You more clearly and my ears to hear anything You desire to speak. I pray for a Spirit of wisdom and revelation that I might know Jesus more deeply and have a profound understanding of the hope that is in His heart for me.

Day 9, January 19: to set the desire of your heart

Psalm 27:4: One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple.

Psalm 37:4: Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart.

Prayer:

Lord I want You to be the top priority of my life with nothing even close in second place. Help me, Father, to love You more than I ever have before. I want You to fill my heart, all of it, so Your love and grace can flow richly through me to everyone I come in contact with.

Day 10, January 20: to continue to seek God first

Psalm 9:10: Those who know your name trust in You, for You, Lord, have never forsaken those who seek You.

Jeremiah 29:13: You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

1 Chronicles 29:13: Now devote your heart and soul to seeking the Lord your God.

Colossians 3:2: Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Prayer:

Father God, thank You for these last 21 days of focusing on You. Thank You for the promise that You will be found when I seek You. Thank you that You don't hide from me but that You constantly draw me near to You. Please put a hunger and a thirst in my life for You Lord. You are so beautiful. So amazing. So, forgiving. So good. And I am deciding to chase after You with all of my heart from this day on. Daily. Lord, may I put You first and seek Your face. Daily. I love you, Lord and I want to love and know You more. Amen.

Day 11, January 21: to be filled with God's glory

Psalm 22:27-28: All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations will bow down before him, for dominion belongs to the Lord and he rules over the nations.

Habakkuk 2:14: For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.

Prayer:

Sovereign God, I pray that the believers in our community would be a city set on a hill and 'salt and light' to the world. I ask that we would influence other nations with righteousness. I pray You give me Your perspective on reaching this world with the Love of Jesus. Lord, instill in me a passion to join You in the mission of pursuing people to know You so that You are glorified among all nations and peoples. Lord, may I hunger and thirst after You and desire that for all people.

Day 12, January 22: to experience God's presence and power

Psalm 43:3-4: Send me your light and your faithful care, let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy mountain, to the place where you dwell. Then I will go to the altar of God, to God, my joy and my delight. I will praise you with the lyre, O God, my God.

Prayer:

God, I pray that Your Spirit comes down in real and powerful ways in my life. Come alongside me today and demonstrate who You are. Show me the power of Your radical love, show me who I am because of what You have done, and show me how that can impact those around me with Your will and love. Come alongside me in my interactions with others, in my conversations with You, and in how I treat my family and my friends. Be near to me, show me Your presence and Your power, and make me a different person because of how You love me. But more than anything, I pray that You show up in my life. I acknowledge that there is no church, there is no faith without You, and so I pray that You are present and vibrant in all that I think, say, and do.

Day 13, January 23: to uphold righteousness and justice

Psalm 89:14: Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you.

Matthew 6:33: But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Prayer:

Father God, Your Word shows that You care deeply for those that are suffering under injustice. Thank You for Your father heart that upholds the oppressed. I ask that You would be with our leaders and work through them as You have so many times throughout history. Give them a passion to establish just laws and the wise discernment they need to solve issues. Where there is a lack of passion, move in their hearts to create an urgency to uphold justice. Give me a

fire to stand for those who are suffering all kinds of injustice. Show me how I can work to influence those around me, and move in my own community to show Your love and compassion. May Your Kingdom come even now!

Day 14, January 24: to be cleansed of sin

Psalm 25:18: Look on my affliction and my distress and take away all my sins.

Nehemiah 1:6b, 8-9 (NIV): I confess the sins we Israelites, including myself and my father's house, have committed against you. We have acted very wickedly toward you. Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations, but if you return to me and obey my commands, then even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon, I will gather them from there and bring them to the place I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name.'

Prayer:

Holy God, I understand that a city or region cannot receive Your blessing if it is built on sin and bloodshed. That type of foundation causes the people to labor and gain nothing. Lord, we humbly ask Your mercy and for Your forgiveness to be poured out in the community we live in. Lord, at this time I also name the specific sins that I am aware of such as injustices or covenant breaking, and I repent of them. I ask that You use me in my community wherever you desire so that You are glorified and seen in our midst.

Fasting Tips

- Keep your fridge and pantry stocked with the items you need. Being unprepared to fast sets you up to give into temptation.
- Make it a priority to attend church and as many of the Saturday Morning Prayer times as you can during your 21-day fast. Being around other believers will encourage you to keep on going when fasting gets difficult.
- Make sure you replace the thing you removed through fasting with spiritual activities. Read your Bible, listen to messages online, pray, spend time with family, etc.
- If you are fasting with others, you may want to meet together in a small- group setting. You can share what God is showing you in your devotional time as well as spend time in prayer together.
- If you mess up, don't get discouraged. Just get right back on track and keep going. God's mercies "are new every morning" (Lamentations 3:22-23). He wants you to finish, and He will give you the grace and strength to do it.

Health Tips for Fasting

- **Water Intake.** While fasting, it is imperative to drink plenty of water. Typically, it is recommended that you drink half your body weight in ounces of water per day on a typical day. For example, a 160-pound person should drink 80 ounces of water. However, when total fasting, it is highly recommended that you increase your water intake to around 100 ounces per day at minimum. This will also aid in your body's detoxification process.
- For those total fasting, use distilled water for the first 3-4 days as this will help shut down your digestive system quicker.
- While fasting, your digestive system will begin to cleanse itself of the many toxins in your body and you will have much more frequent bowel movements. This is normal and to be expected.
- The toxins in your body will also be released through your breath. Carry a toothbrush and toothpaste or small mints. Chewing gum is not recommended if total fasting, as it will stimulate your digestive system.
- Avoid food smells during the first few days of total fasting, as it will intensify the hunger pains.
