Sunday Worship (Beginning November 29th)

We have taken the following steps to keep healthy those worshipping with us in-person:

- Please wear a mask when entering the building and until you find your seat.
- Masks are recommended during the worship service, but optional.
- The front areas under the wings of the balcony are designated for any elderly and immunocompromised who wish to keep a bit more distance.
- We have clearly marked pews and sections of pews that are unavailable for seating.
- Multiple hand sanitization continue to be located at the doors to the Worship Center.
- The bathrooms in the vestibule (closest ones to the Worship Center) continue to be available for the elderly and the immunocompromised. These are cleaned periodically throughout the morning.
- When the morning service is over, should you desire to linger and talk, please do so outside the building.
