Mark 4:8, *“Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up, grew and produced a crop, some multiplying thirty, some sixty, some a hundred times.”*

Galatians 6:1-2, *“Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently. But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted. Carry each other’s burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.”*

1. STEP 1: “Restore that person \_\_\_\_\_.”
  - a. Don’t be demeaning; have a voicetone of \_\_\_\_\_, not one of \_\_\_\_\_.
    - “Don’t \_\_\_\_\_...”
  - b. The best way to open the conversation is by asking a question.
    - Confrontation needs to be a “\_\_\_\_\_” not a “\_\_\_\_\_.”
  
2. STEP 2: Verbalize the issue \_\_\_\_\_, with a lack of demeaning voicetone.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ your words.
  - It helps to \_\_\_\_\_ the other person and makes it easier to come to resolution.

3. STEP 3: \_\_\_\_\_ that person.

a. It isn't just about realignment, but helping the person be better on the other side.

- Learn the “\_\_\_\_\_ behind the \_\_\_\_\_.”

4. STEP 4: Watch yourself lest you also be \_\_\_\_\_.

5. STEP 5: Give them a chance to \_\_\_\_\_.
