

## **FAQ's**

**Q - I previously RSVPd through the first google form for a service. Do I need to register again?**

A - Yes! Since we have had to limit the attendance to 150 persons per service, registration through the Eventbrite links is necessary. These links can be found on our website at [www.templebaptistfay.com/temple-together](http://www.templebaptistfay.com/temple-together).

**Q - What precautions are being taken before my arrival on campus?**

A - Please know we are committed to protecting your health and safety and remain vigilant in taking every precaution possible. Thank you for remaining prayerful, faithful, and flexible in these times.

Precautions include:

- Limited Seating - To ensure adequate social distancing, we are limiting the number of people in the Worship Center to 150 persons.
- Increased Cleaning - Portions of the building, specifically worship areas, restrooms, and high-traffic areas, are thoroughly sanitized before, between and after services. We are using an EPA approved sanitizing product on all surfaces, including our worship center seats.
- Mask Stations - Masks are not required, but should you feel more comfortable using one, we have one available for you. You are also encouraged to bring your own mask, if you desire.
- Hand Sanitizer Stations - Stations with hand sanitizers are provided at each entrance.
- Social Distancing (six-foot requirement) - Proper distancing will be adhered in service for your protection. Please follow distancing requirement throughout building; fellowship outside the church building is encouraged, if you are comfortable to do so in the open air.
- Touchless Environment - No worship area paper items will be available and offering plates will not be passed. Bibles, pens, offering envelopes, and all other informational items have been removed . All internal church doors will remain open and drinking fountains will be turned off.

**Q - How can I provide my offering?**

A - In order to provide a “touchless environment,” offering plates will not be passed. Other giving methods are available, however, including dropping a check/cash in the Generosity Boxes in the lobby and worship center. You may also give online on our church website or app.

**Q - Will childcare be provided for any services?**

A - At this time there will be no childcare for our on campus worship gatherings. We will provide worship packets for your children with activities to help them remain engaged during the service. In addition, beginning June 7, our fellowship hall will be available for any families with young children who need to exit the worship center during the service. Our live stream will be available in that room and children can have the freedom to relax and move around more freely, as much as parents are comfortable.

**Q - When will our Sunday School class meet on campus again?**

A - We are working on a plan to phase in our small groups at the appropriate time. Classroom are a much smaller and more confined space, which makes social distancing more of a challenge. At this time groups will continue to meet virtually.

**Q - I understand our childcare center, Temple Christian Academy, is open with children in the building. What safety precautions are being taken at TCA?**

A - Our TCA staff is working hard to keep our kids safe and our center clean and sanitized. Since our childcare center is licensed by the state of NC, we are required to follow state guidelines, regulations, and procedures. No parents or guests are permitted inside the center. Children are dropped off in the daycare foyer. Each child is screened, having their temperature checked and hands washed before entering the center. The child is then escorted to their classroom by a TCA employee. Each classroom, and toys, are sanitized daily, at the end of each day.
