BCS Kindergarten School Supply List – Mrs. Herning

- Pencil box labeled with child's name (to fit crayons, pencil, eraser, glue stick, scissors & colored pencils)
- 2 erasers (white Pentel hi-polymer work best – these are not pencil-top erasers)
- (2) 2-pocket folders labeled with your child's name
- 3 glue sticks
- 8 count Crayola crayons
- 1 child scissors labeled with your child's name
- 12 count Crayola colored pencils (will be kept in personal pencil box)
- 1 reusable water bottle labeled with child's name (sent home nightly to wash)
- 1 pair of P.E. shoes that stay at school labeled with child's name (Velcro only – unless child can tie their own shoes)
- 1 extra set of clothing including socks and underpants in a large Ziploc bag labeled with child's name (you may stick in a 4x6 family photo; this is in the event of an emergency)

- 2 reams of white 8.5 x 11 computer/copier paper
- 2 containers cleaning wipes
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 bottle of XL size hand sanitizer (*the one made with aloe does not cause as much skin dryness)

- Last names (A-H) box gallon-size Ziplock bags; last names (I-P) box sandwich-size Ziplock bags; last names (Q-Z) box snack-size Ziplock bags

**Note:

- Please do not send in items that are not on the list.
- Please keep in mind that the pencil boxes will store only so many supplies, keeping the supplies at the above counts will ensure space in their storage boxes and will keep everything uniform. At this time markers are not necessary.
- Throughout the year, I will put out a request in our weekly newsletter looking for volunteers to bring in classroom snacks – Gold Fish Crackers, Animal Crackers, Graham Crackers, and Ritz Crackers (*note: these must be individually packaged).

Middle School Grades Supply List

2"- 3" 3 ring binder (this is the most effective way to stay organized. Having multiple binders leads to lost assignments and not having the proper supplies for class)

In the Binder:

- 8 dividers – 1 for each class and an extra for plain paper
- 1 zipper pencil pouch stocked with:
 - 2 blue/black pens and 2 red pens
 - Mechanical pencils -- as many as your child needs – a pencil sharpener is not always available.
 - 1 generic calculator (8th graders need a scientific calculator)
 - Erasers – if your child needs them (the large pink ones are best)
 - Colored pencils
 - 2 highlighters (color does not matter)
 - Math Compass – 7th grade only
- College ruled paper – 3 packs (1 pack in binder, 1 pack at home for homework, and 1 pack to share in the class)
- 3 single subject spiral notebooks (1 for Bible, 1 for English, and 1 for Math)
- 5 pocket folders (they need brads, but the plastic ones hold up best, please be sure that you have 1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 green, and 1 red) – they need to last all year
- Student Planner (optional, but helpful)
- 3 large, black dry erase markers (to be brought to school and left in the classroom)
- 2 reams of white copy paper (drop at office)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 containers cleaning wipes (Clorox, etc)
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 XL bottle of hand sanitizer with pump

***Other supplies may be required as the year progresses. Please replenish as needed.

All students must have:
