- Personal size white-board (labeled with child's name) with 2 dry-erase markers

- 1 square plastic milk-type crate for winter gear and extra change of clothes – labeled with child's name
- 1 extra set of clothing including socks and underpants in a large Ziploc bag labeled with child's name
- 50 count plastic spoons
- 1 package classic color 8.5 x 11 cardstock
- 1 large box of tissues
- 2 reams of white 8.5 x 11 computer/copier paper
- 1 package of wet wipes/baby unscented wipes (for personal hygiene)

Optional

- 12 count Crayola colored pencils (Will be kept in personal pencil box)

****Note:** please keep in mind that the pencil boxes will store only so many supplies, keeping the supplies at the above counts will ensure space in their storage boxes and will keep everything uniform. At this time markers are not necessary.

- 1 zipper pencil pouch stocked with:

Mechanical pencils -- as many as your child needs – a pencil sharpener is not always available.

2 blue/black pens and 2 red pens

Erasers – if your child needs them (the large pink ones are best)

1 generic calculator (8th graders need a scientific calculator)

2 highlighters (color does not matter)

Colored pencils

Math Compass – 7th grade only

College ruled paper – 3 packs (1 pack in binder, 1 pack at home for homework, and 1 pack to share in the class)

3 single subject spiral notebooks (1 for Bible, 1 for English, and 1 for Math)

5 pocket folders (they need brads, but the plastic ones hold up best, please be sure that you have 1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 green, and 1 red) – they need to last all year

Planner: I will provide a planner for each student (6-7th Grades), please be prepared to ask your child about the planner and be ready to sign it for the first month of school

3 large, black dry erase markers (to be brought to school and left in the classroom)
