



Plan for Re-Opening Youth & Children's Ministries on Sundays

Dated September 17, 2020

All Sundays until further notice

Children

- The Nursery is open for children 4 months- 3 years
- Parents will need to walk their children 4 years-4th grade to the playground. They will not need to check in at the computer kiosk. We will keep a handwritten attendance list at the playground.
- We will spend most of our time on the playground but will come into the Lodge for our lesson time. We will have colored tape on the floor to mark where children can sit. Students will be spread out at least 6 ft. from each other.
- Parents will pick up kids after service from the playground.
- Children will wash their hands before and after playing on the playground.
- The outdoor play equipment and seating area in the Lodge will be sanitized between services.
- We will encourage families to send their children and youth to Sunday School with a water bottle since we will not have the water fountains in use.
- Children 5 years and older need to wear a mask—we have masks for kids as well as youth if they do not have their own.

Youth

- Youth will head straight to the youth room for Solid Ground Sunday School
- Any games involving youth will involve minimum 6 feet of distance from each other.
- Chairs will be spaced 6 feet apart for the youth lesson
- Depending on the size of the group, small groups following the lesson will either take place in the main youth room, or in spaced out breakout groups in the adjacent classrooms.
- Youth need to be picked up by their parent after service is over.

*In the case of smoke or weather, kids will need to be dropped off directly in the Lodge. Please make sure you are on our email list so you can receive the weekly emails with what to expect for Sundays.
