Entering the Church

- The Lower Lobby entrance will be open.
- Masks will be required by everyone to attend services. We thank you in advance for doing your part to protect others and prevent the spread of COVID-19. If you forget your mask, we will have some available.
- We will be taking everyone's temperature and recording who is attending. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 will be requested to return home.
- There will be hand sanitizer at the entrance for everyone to sanitize their hands before entering further into the building.
- There will be greeters and ushers to help you know where to check in, and signage to help you maintain social distancing.

Seating in Fellowship Hall

- Seating in Fellowship Hall is socially distanced.
- Please stay 6-feet away from others attending service to follow the government guidelines as well as to assist in the comfort of those around you who would like to maintain social distancing.
- Please do not change or move seats – we have carefully planned how to maintain social distancing as well as allow for quick cleaning between services.
- If you would like to give an offering, you may continue to give online, or there will be baskets at the back of the room where you may place your offering.

Other Areas of the Church

- 2 people are allowed in each restroom at a time.
- Restrooms and other public spaces will be sanitized between services.
- Please do not enter closed areas of the church. This enables us to know which areas need to be cleaned.

Before You Come to UPPC

- If you feel ill or have any symptoms of COVID-19, please stay home and get well!
- If you have been exposed to anyone in the past week who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or has COVID-19 symptoms, please do not attend church out of an abundance of caution.
