

ELDER STATEMENT: UPPC Elders are elected by the congregation having demonstrated leadership skills and being persons of deep faith, maturity, wisdom, and compassion, knowing themselves and others as beloved children of God. They are called together, based on their unique giftedness, to share in discerning and responding to the movement of the Holy Spirit, offering servant leadership in strengthening and nurturing the church body's faith and life together.

TEAM PURPOSE: to provide a strong, visible stewardship role in the development, preservation and use of the church facilities and equipment in support of a safe and appropriate physical setting for staff and the congregation to carry out the work and ministry of UPPC.

CORE LEADERSHIP:

Executive Minister
Two Elders

DOWNLINE TEAMS:

Team of volunteer church members dedicated to maintaining and modifying church facilities and grounds as directed.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Hold the team and its ministry in prayer, acknowledging and relying on God's presence and leading.
- Develop and review policies and procedures for the operation, use and security of church facilities, associated real properties and equipment.
- Support and assist the Executive Minister as necessary.
- Facilitate the landscaping and maintenance of the grounds.
- Facilitate the annual and long-range planning process for Facilities & Grounds.
- Maintain, repair, modify and oversee the operation of church Facilities, including built-in equipment and systems.
- Work with the Executive Minister on acquisition and use of church personal property and equipment.
- Meet once a month as a team.
- Represent the Facilities Team to Session and Session to the Facilities & Grounds Team
