- ✓ Developing a congregational and individual Christ-centered, needs-oriented focus that is practical and challenges us to grow.
- ✓ Nurturing a closer and more personal relationship with our Lord and with each other.
- ✓ Fostering a greater sense of "community" by serving our neighbors and others within the Lord's body.

Our world is full of hurt and disappointment. Life throws out curves. Evil is real. While the spiritual battles going on around us are invisible, the carnage is real. We see it in broken families, embattled marriages, addiction, and a society that is becoming openly hostile to God. The storms of life are real. Throughout our community, people are being battered and broken by the violent and unpredictable waves of life. Where can they find safe harbor? Where can they find a place of rest and healing? Where can they find hope?



During 2011, Kettering Church of Christ is committed to becoming a place of safety, refuge and hope. We want to deepen our trust in God and each other. We are committed to demonstrating the love of Christ with compassion for all. Our mission is to be a rescue station where the lost can find salvation, and those inside Christ can rely on spiritual training, encouragement, and edification from brothers and sisters in Christ.

To begin the process of becoming more aware of our mission, we intend to spend the first part of 2011 helping those within our family build and equip themselves with the skills necessary to care for those who are outside Christ. As we move into the second part of the year, we wish to implement a number of initiatives that will take the gospel deeper into our community – serving as a bright light into an increasingly gloomy and dark world. Very simply, our work will be divided into three phases:

- ✓ **Build:** Building a Foundation for Evangelism
- ✓ **Equip:** *Training for Duty*
- ✓ **Execute:** *Taking the Mission Outside*

This booklet has been designed as a practical guide for the year. We urge you to keep it with you and refer to it often. On your calendar, be sure to make a note of the opportunities that have been planned for the year. Remember, as we go throughout the year, our commitment is to glorify God in all we do. We have been *marked out by Him to be made like His Son,* Romans 8.29.

- ✓ Revamp our congregational website and effectively use electronic media to increase our congregational visibility and send the message of Christ.


## **Building a Foundation for Spiritual Growth**


