A Message from the Elders

Coming into 2014, it is painfully apparent the movement to remove God from all aspects of life is gaining ground. To some, the name *Christian* is viewed as a radical or extremist title. Those accusers believe any references to God or Christianity must be removed from the public square. Every day organized opposition is doing everything possible to take God out of our lives.

In July of 2013 a school system here in Ohio agreed to pay a \$95,000.00 fine to settle a lawsuit brought by the A.C.L.U. and a group called *The Freedom From Religion Foundation*. Their crime? Since 1947 a portrait of Jesus had hung on a wall in the high school entitled the "Hall of Honor". His portrait was included with a number of other notable historical figures who had made a difference in the founding, growth, and prosperity of our country.

We ask ourselves why is this happening? We wonder how a society raised to know God has walked away from their faith. How is it possible that the government once unafraid to credit God as the Creator who has endowed us with certain unalienable rights has seemingly turned their back on Him? Why is our culture losing its respect for God and actively working to make Him irrelevant?

The sad reality is we have made God common. We have lost sight of who He really is and no longer respect His holiness. In Leviticus 10:3 God said through Moses:

It is what the Lord spoke saying, "By those who come near me I will be treated as holy, and before all the people I will be honored."

In 2014 our theme will be "A Holy Calling." Our focus will be on truly understanding who God is and responding with the reverence He deserves.

We want to equip everyone to refute the claims of those who would deny Him as the Creator or deny the record of the flood or the age of the earth. We want our children to have the confidence of the scriptures engrained in their hearts so they can withstand the onslaught of teaching from our schools, universities, science community, and media outlets. We will study fundamental doctrines found in the very beginning of scripture concerning marriage, the sanctity of life, and the promise of the Messiah.

- During Quarter 1, we will work to clarify and validate the evidence of the existence of God and the truth of the Biblical record.
- In **Quarter 2** we will discuss the question David asked in Psalm 8.4: Why are you mindful of me?
- Quarter 3 will look at the response of those whose lives were changed when they came to know God.
- Finally, **Quarter 4** will conclude the year by learning how we can become Holy as He is Holy, 1 Peter 1.15.

It is time we remove the doubts and boldly pronounce that God is alive and warn this nation that it must turn back to Him if we expect His continued blessing.

We are excited about the Vision Plan for 2014. We hope you will embrace all that we have planned for the year. Above all, we pray for this church and our families that we may truly come to know God. Join us in praying for our nation to turn back to God and treat Him as Holy once again!

Moving Forward

Maybe as you read the Message from the elders you were saying to yourself *I already know God*. While we all know God, the question is *do we REALLY know God*? Do you understand how Christ dying on the cross makes sense in the whole of scripture? Maybe you are asking yourself, what does it matter?

If we allow the world to discredit the very foundation of the Bible, then we should not be surprised that God becomes no more than a good story of a mythical character to tell our children about. If they do not see Genesis 1 through 12 as factual then why should we expect them to remain faithful later in life as teachers and professors tell them the Biblical record is not true?

It seems if we truly know God:

- We would take every opportunity to assemble for worship or Bible studies when those opportunities are available.
- We would spend time with those who know God and work to grow in our faith.
- We would eliminate many of the things we allow into our homes through a television or computer.
- We would talk daily with our children and grandchildren about how God has made a difference in our lives.

Sadly many people look at Christianity as being a part of their life, instead of being their life.

The following is an article written by Bro. Perry Hall a few years ago.

He writes:

The Gospel is not words, parables, philosophies, or platitudes; although the gospel is told in all those forms. The gospel is flesh, lived in the flesh, suffered and triumphed in the flesh; the purpose to be ultimately imitated by us in our flesh.

That is the real transforming power of the gospel. God did not send a prophet or story teller only. God did not send just a teacher or philosopher. God sent God. The Father sent the Son in a form foreign to Himself to teach us how to live contrary to ourselves. And in living contrary to ourselves, the paradoxical truth is learned that in such living we live truly to ourselves. In denying ourselves we find ourselves. We learn to live like Jesus lived; and to die like Jesus died.

The weakness found in so many Christians' lives is that the gospel is learned but not led; understood but not undertaken. To truly be a Christian, we must be Christ-like. Power is found in not just telling the story of the woman caught in adultery, but to be that woman, and to be the Christ who forgave her. Supremacy above self is discovered by not just seeing ourselves as the Pharisee who did not wash Jesus' feet, but to become the woman who covered His feet with her tears. The weakness in so many of us is that we know the gospel story intellectually but fail to see the heart of it. The gospel is not just about knowing who Jesus is, but why Jesus came. It is more than just coming to save me, but encompasses coming to lead me to save others.

Too many Christians live weak lives because they fail to see the power in how the gospel story is told. It is told by being lived; and retold in us by being imitated to where the imitation becomes our reality. We become the gospel.

During 2014, we hope you will step back and make an honest evaluation of your life. Join with the apostle Paul in Galatians 2.20 when he said; *I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.*

changes for 2014

As you look through our vision plan for this year, you will notice a few changes in our Sunday afternoon schedule. The purpose of these changes is to continue our efforts to provide greater spiritual growth, development, as well as stronger relationships within the Kettering family. For example:

- Targeted Studies: Every fourth Sunday we will present a study focused on a specific need within the congregation. Not every targeted study will apply to every member, however, when it does apply to you we ask that you be here.
- Song Services: On months with a fifth Sunday, we want to have an areawide singing event. - **Summer Series**: This year we intend to invite a few outside speakers for selected Wednesday evening Summer Series lessons.

But as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy." - 1 Peter 1.15-16

Despite biblical admonitions to be holy, many question what that really means. **Being holy** simply means to be set apart for a special purpose by God. When God told Israel to be holy in Leviticus 11 and 19, He was instructing them to be distinct from the other nations. He gave them specific regulations to set them apart from the nations around.

Today God asks us to be holy by living a life that reflects Him, 2 Corinthians 6.16-17. Ultimately, this means setting ourselves apart from our will and completely yielding to His.

During this quarter we will:

- Sharpen our commitment to set ourselves apart from the sin filled environment surrounding us.
- Give attention to how we treat others, our speech, our attitude, and a willingness to avoid the sinful enticements of the world readily available to us today.
- Consider every thought, action and reaction and how it aligns to what God would expect from His children professing holiness.
