Special Church Council Meeting & Charge Conference

There will be a special called Church Council and Charge Conference for TODAY Sunday, April 3, immediately following 11 am worship in The Faith Center. The purpose of both meetings is to act on a recommendation from the Trustees to sell the Montgomery Building at 108 Barnwell Ave NW. The proceeds from the sale will be used to demolish the Annex Building and reconfigure the rear parking lot so that more parking spaces can be created behind the Ebenezer Building. The purchasers have agreed that parking will still be available on Sundays at the Montgomery Building. The remainder of the proceeds will be put in Contingency Funds to be used at the discretion of the Church Council.
