COVID-19 POLICY UPDATE: PLEASE READ

Friends, Here is a brief summary of our reopening protocols. Thanks for your faithfulness and patience during this difficult time. We hope to loosen our restrictions even more in the weeks to come. For a more detailed plan, go to www.stjaiken.org. These plans are subject to change as needed.

Reopening Protocols

- Masks are optional! If for personal reasons or health concerns, please wear masks.
- Choirs and Band will wear masks while singing.
- If you have been feeling unwell, please do not attend.
- No Temp checks, but hand sanitizer will be available.
- Sit wherever you want, with 3 feet or one arm's length between households.
- We will skip every other pew or row of chairs in the worship areas.
- Bathrooms are available at your discretion.
- Limit physical contact by reserving hugs, handshakes, and fist bumps for outdoors.
- Limit face-to-face contact to no longer than 10 minutes.
- Offering may be placed in baskets near each exit.
- No food or beverages are allowed in worship areas.

Sunday School and Other Ministries

- You can use your usual space, with appropriate distancing.
- 3 feet distancing or one chair between households.
- Masks are optional unless there is inadequate airflow.
- Alternate spaces, if necessary, are Ward Hall 1-3, Gym, Chapel, & Faith Center, on a first come, first serve basis.


