Bishop Jonathon Holston has provided new guidance in response to COVID and the Omicron Variant. The link to the exact statement is https://www.umcsc.org/bestpractices/. Although all are welcome to worship with us and have their usual meetings and classes, masks are required, and unless from the same household, please try to keep an arm's length distance from others. We hope this variant passes soon and we can return to mask-optional in weeks rather than months. This guidance is for every activity inside our facilities.
