Consider how God has provided for you this past year and how out of that abundance, you can participate at Valley Chapel. 



BIBLE STUDY God reveals his plan for the world through the scriptures. I have spent time reading the bible this year
LEADERSHIP I have committed to carry the responsibility to lead others in my church community
PRAYER I cultivate trust in God through regular prayers of praise, confession, thanks, and request
VOLUNTEER I gave my time toward the work of the church consistently as an event volunteer or as a part of a team
TRY SOMETHING NEW I have tried to connect with God and/or others in a way I had not tried before this year
