

Nuts & Bolts Fidget Spinner

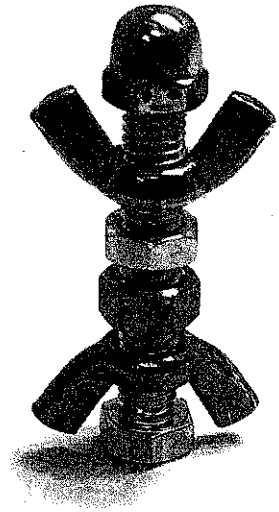
DAY 3: FOUNDATION OF WORTH

BIBLE STORY: Wise and Foolish Builders (Matthew 7:24-29)

TODAY'S POINT: Jesus' love is the foundation for the rest of my life. (Grades 1–6)

CRAFT CONNECTION

Welcome the kids to Crafts. Ask kids to recall the point of today's Bible study. (*Jesus' love is the foundation for the rest of my life.*) Show the sample fidget spinner you have made. Demonstrate how the wing nut spins freely but is always stopped by the cap nut. Remind the kids that they can trust Jesus' love to be their firm foundation.



GATHER SUPPLIES

- Everyday Supplies
- Wing nuts (2 per child)
- 2–2½-inch bolt (1 per child)
- Hex nuts (2 per child)
- Cap nut (1 per child)
- Permanent markers

ADVANCE PREPARATION

- Make a sample fidget spinner.

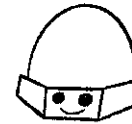
LEADER TIP

Thread the wing nuts and hex nuts onto the bolt before coloring to provide a place to hold them.

ASSEMBLE

Step 1: Use permanent markers to color the wing nuts and hex nuts.

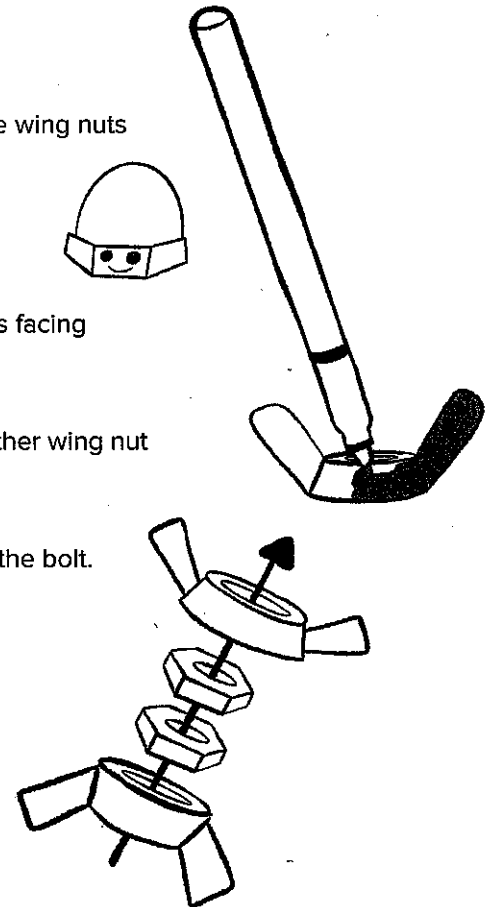
Step 2: Draw a face on the cap nut.



Step 3: Thread one wing nut with the wings facing down onto the bolt.

Step 4: Thread the two hex nuts and the other wing nut facing up onto the bolt.

Step 5: Screw the cap nut onto the end of the bolt.



Galvanized Coin Pouch

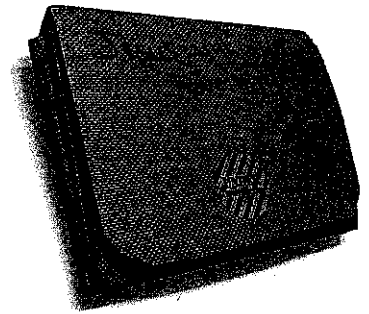
DAY 3: FOUNDATION OF WORTH

BIBLE STORY: Jesus' Resurrection and Promise (Matthew 28:1-10,16-20)

TODAY'S POINT: Jesus will always love me. (Grades 1-6)

CRAFT CONNECTION

Welcome the kids to Crafts. Ask the kids to recall the Point for today. (*Jesus will always love me.*) Remind kids that because we know Jesus loves us we should want to share that good news with others. Show them the coin pouch and tell them they will make a pouch to collect coins to give to missions or at church to help others learn how much Jesus loves them.



GATHER SUPPLIES

- Everyday Supplies
- 8½-by-11-inch silver scrapbook paper (1 sheet per child)
- 8½-by-11-inch thin cardboard (1 sheet per child)
- Dull pencils (1 per child)
- Velcro® circles (1 set per child)
- Rulers (1 per child)
- VBS 2020 Theme Stickers (005817939) or other theme related stickers
- "Pouch Template"

ADVANCE PREPARATION

- Copy and cut out one "Pouch Template" per child from the cardboard.
- Trace the lines to be scored on each piece of cardboard.
- Make a sample coin pouch.

LEADER TIPS

- Use cardboard cereal or food boxes to add color and skip the scrapbook paper steps.
- Score the cardboard in advance for younger children.
- Materials for a similar craft can be found in the *VBS 2020 Galvanized Coin Pouch Craft Pack* (005821548).

ASSEMBLE

Step 1: Cut out template with duct tape on the back.

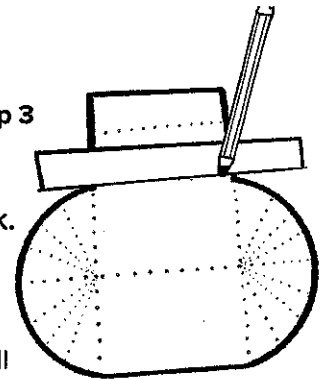
Step 2: Lay the ruler along each dotted line and use a dull pencil or closed pen to score each line.

Step 3: Fold the template on the scored lines. Use an accordion fold on the sides of the pouch.

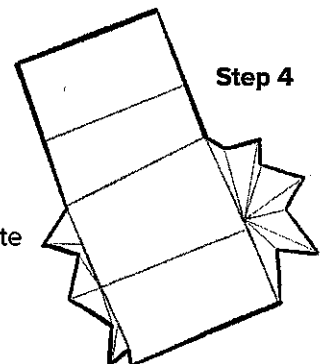
Step 4: Place one sticky side of the Velcro dot on the inside of the flap on the pouch. Stick the opposite side of the Velcro to it. Close the flap and the second Velcro dot will automatically stick to the correct spot on the pouch.

Step 5: Print *Jesus will always love me* across the flap of the pouch. Decorate with stickers as desired.
