Wisdom for the Young

Wisdom is something we often talk about in the context age. The older the person, the more wise they are perceived to be. And, this is often true. With age comes the application of knowledge. What was simply theory at the age of 12 becomes experience at some point along the way at age 65. Now, I understand that many times our 12 year olds act like they know everything... but that's simply because they don't know what they don't know yet. It's recency bias. After all, mom and dad, you were never a 12 year old the way I was a 12 year old!

But is wisdom really only for the aged? I don't believe so. I think the Holy Spirit works in the young to bring about wisdom in a way that often is foreign the older we get. Often we consider ourselves wise because of experience (and there is a significant element to that) but this reliance on experience can also lead us to arrogance. A genuine seeking of wisdom in the young leads them to focus on teaching and instruction of others. They have no experience to fall back on so they rely on others and God to grant them wisdom prior to the experience. And many times, that's what we as parents so badly WANT to articulate to our kids. Don't learn from experience like I did! Gain wisdom from others and God to avoid having to learn the hard way!

This month, we dive into the book of Proverbs. Specifically Proverbs 1 and 15 and we explore the idea of wisdom in the young, God's granting of it, and the way we can encourage young people to grow in it!
