Faith—The Strutt in Your Struggle

Pastor Bouyer's Sermon Series – Heroes of the Faith from Hebrews 11 has been nothing less than inspirational for the past few weeks. Recently, during one of his messages, Pastor Bouyer talked about the strut in your struggle. This message resonated with me as I vividly remembered a situation where I strutted in the midst of my struggle.

God is faithful. Of this, I am sure. And just in case you're not, maybe this will help...

My husband had lymphoma and could no longer work. We had received his last paycheck and were waiting for his disability from to begin. To try to help make ends meet, I got a job as a cashier at the local Sav-A-Lot. But that was short lived because when you've got chemo and radiation running through your body, the ability to take care of six children is just not feasible. So, I quit my job. With my last paycheck, I paid all the bills I could, but there wasn't enough to pay them all. The deep freezer and both refrigerators were empty, and there's no need to mention what was in

the cabinets.

I've always known and believed that God could do anything, but this time He showed me He could go beyond doing just anything!

One evening I was in the kitchen literally cooking our last meal. The doorbell rang, then my son came into the kitchen to tell me there was a woman at our door asking if I lived there. Curious as to who was asking for me, I went to the door. The woman began to explain that she was in a meeting with someone that was asking for prayers for my family and had provided information about our current situation. She said that God had sent her there to help my family with whatever we needed. She then handed me \$500 cash. loaded me and a couple of my kids up and took us to the grocery store. The grocery bill was over \$500.

I am grateful for Nancy and her husband, Tim, because over the course of approximately 6 months, they consistently blessed my family with groceries and money.

Grocery trips happened every 3 to 4 weeks with a total bill of \$500 or more each time. Monetary gifts were given in amounts beyond my imagination at the time. All this from people who only knew us by the word of someone else. Through Tim and Nancy's obedience and generosity, we were able to pay off our minivan, almost eradicate our debt, and purchase much needed beds for all six of my children.

Philippians 4:19 says that my God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory. During this time, I was writing this scripture on every check I wrote. Even when I wasn't sure if the money would be in the bank to cover it. Somehow it would always be there! I knew and still know that God will take care of me. He is Jehovah Jireh, my provider!

In this situation, not only did God provide, but God showed up and out!!
