*Summary:*

Gospel Community Church is seeking to fill the role of Family Ministries Director. The man or woman in this role will fulfill the following duties:

The Family Ministries Director supports the mission and vision of Gospel Community Church (GCC) by providing oversight and leadership for Family Ministry. This position is also responsible for the execution of GCC's vision and mission within Family Ministry, set by the Lead Elders and Central Leadership Team (CLT) of GCC. While the role will primarily lead and function within our Rivermont campus, the person in this role will also serve GCC as a whole to help cast vision, share resources, and set a common culture within Family Ministries among all GCC locations.

In light of the overall vision of the church, the role of the Family Ministry Director will be dedicated to creating systems of discipleship for children and youth, as well as looking for opportunities to strengthen the entire family. As a church, GCC desires to create environments where children, students, and parents know, love, and follow Jesus. GCC also desires to equip couples and parents with opportunities and resources to be and make disciples in their homes, communities, and world.

The Family Ministries Director will perform all of his/her duties while helping to embody and set the staff and church culture of GCC. The GCC Staff is made up of Spirit-led, servant-hearted leaders who truly believe we are better together. Dependence on God, selflessness in service and leadership, and a collaborative approach to ministry are critical to the health of the staff team.

*Qualifications:*

1. The Family Ministry Director will need to have the primary spiritual gifts of leadership and administration, and have a passion for shepherding, discipleship, and teaching.
2. At least 2 years experience with children, students, and family ministry and/or Bachelor's degree, or higher, in ministry is strongly preferred.
3. Must be passionate about teaching and equipping God's people to reach the lost for Jesus Christ.
4. A track record of servant-leadership, teamwork, and entrepreneurial ministry.

*Abilities:*

1. Excellent verbal and written communication.
2. Willingness to develop relationships with families and come alongside them in the discipleship of their families (marriage and children).
3. Aptitude and experience in teaching.
4. Familiar with computers, internet, Google suite, speaking on video, etc.
5. Able to research and learn quickly.
6. Stay current with student and family ministry practices by reading, networking, and identifying best practices.

*Expectations and Responsibilities:*

- Act as the primary vision-carrier and communicator for the Family Ministries team in carrying out the mission and vision of making disciples in families.
- Engage in the Pastoral work of shepherding, discipling, and caring for families in various stages of life.
- Lead the leaders of Kid City and Gospel Student Ministries to carry out the mission of glorifying God by making another generation of disciples who love God, grow in community, and reach out with the love of Christ.
- Actively work with Family Ministry staff and volunteers to provide resourcing, care, discipleship, and training that equips families in various forms.
- Lead out of your own marriage/family or singleness, modeling healthy spiritual leadership and relationships.
- Develop resources to be used in the lives of families so that children and parents are experiencing on-going and life-changing relationships with Jesus Christ.
- Oversee and lead special events including baptisms, family dedications, and forums.
