
Please join our leadership team in celebrating God's presence and provision, and let's continue to give him the glorify in all of our intentions and actions!



Tim Moroz, Church Planting Pastor, Gospel Community Providence

"Over the past couple of months, we have been seeking ways to build bridges into our community. We are starting to see some of the early stages of those relationships forming. We are slowly learning the names and stories of our neighbors, co-workers, and other community members. Just the other day, we were slammed with about 15 inches of snow. As I was outside shoveling, I noticed that one of my neighbors could not get out of their house. I decided to walk over and shovel their driveway. About half way through, the owner came running out to say thank you. We ended up finishing the driveway together while listening to each other's stories. I got a chance to share my faith in Jesus and how He has impacted my life over the years. We ended up deciding that our families needed to get together for a "get to know you" night. I was thankful that God opened the door for this first interaction. We are praying that God will do much more! God ordained meetings like these are one of the reasons why we moved to Providence - to see the Lord work in the lives of the people around us."

Claire Riss, Trans World Radio (TWR) Global Partner:

TWR partners with a local church in the city of Leskovac. It has a high population of Roma people. The church itself is made up of Roma individuals, and we help them fund a unique radio program in the Romani language. This broadcast is written specifically for the families in the local mahalas (Roma slums). This amazing church team writes and produces biblical content, stories, and music that can be heard all over Leskovac. This radio program, "By the people, for the people" has powerfully impacted the community. Because the program is associated with the church, it has been easy for listeners to make the connection with the local church body. In fact, most of the church congregation began attending because they first heard the radio program and made the connection to the church. They trust this church team because they are

Roma just like them. The church has grown so much. They have been able to open their own school (huge deal for Roma children) and conduct critical outreach in the region. I got to witness how the gospel message of Jesus Christ can transform this unique people group. Because of Jesus working in and through them, the church team has seen life transformation in the people that live in the Roma slums. One of the men I spoke with (Rama) shared that the violence in Leskovac had been devastating. His brother had been murdered by their schoolmate as a young man. Despite his sorrow and loss, he can now rejoice because Jesus is alive and working through the church in Leskovac. The love of Jesus has blessed and bonded this community. The people of Leskovac now see themselves as family in Christ.
