

## HEBREW LETTER OF THE MONTH OF TAMMUZ


Tzadi is the PIZZA letter of the alef-bet. Tzadi is the letter in Ivrit that makes *the same sound as the middle part of pizza*. Tzadi sort of sounds like a English T and Z together. Tzadi makes a sound that is a lot of fun, and the words that start with the letter Tzadi are fun to say. Look at the pictures below and read them aloud. Sometimes if there is someone we know who is righteous and does their best to keep Torah, we call them a Tzadik (Tzah-deek). Many people think that a Tzadi sort of looks like someone on their knees praising G-D. Neat huh? Hebrew is read from right to left, opposite of English.
