What is Young Navigators?

It is a Bible-based program for children in Kindergarten through 6th grade. Children will memorize and learn God's Word, have game time, crafts and other special events throughout the year.

What Time Do I Have To Be Here?

Check-in is 6:15-6:30, club starts at 6:30, pick-up is 8:00-8:15pm.

How Much Will This Cost?

\$13.00 Dues for the year (or \$0.50/week**)

\$10.00 Club Vest/Shirt*

\$5.00 Handbook

**If the child's previous year's vest/shirt is in good condition you can trade it in for the new vest/shirt at no cost.*

What Does My Child Need To Bring Each Week?

Club Vest/Shirt, Handbook, Bible and Dues**

What Should My Child Wear?

We have a game-time most nights so we ask that children be dressed in modest, comfortable and safe clothing and shoes.

Who Can Pick Up My Child?

For the safety and wellbeing of your child, we will only release your child to authorized persons identified on the list you fill out.

How Can I Help My Child?

We ask that parents help their child with the memorization of the verses. They will need to know the reference and the verse. It will be difficult for the child to do all of the memorization work just at club, so your time working with them will make a significant difference in their successful progress through the book.

How Do the Awards Work?

When your child completes the **Gateway Test**, they are "awarded" their vest and book. (and after they've been paid for)

At the end of Course 1 they will receive their **Navigator Badge**.

At the end of each Course 2-5 they will receive one of their

'N, E, W, S' Sticker Awards.

At the end of Course 6 your child will receive their **Book Award Sticker** and will also receive a special award on Awards Night.

Attendance Awards are given for attending 8 out of 10 club weeks. This will be awarded 3 times throughout the year.

Clubber must be in uniform to receive any of these Awards.

Is My Child On Pace To Finish Their Book?

There are 6 Courses in the Book and 30 weeks of club, so your child should complete a Course every 5 weeks to be on pace.

Ministry, Music, Worship & Patriotism Activities

These Activities are in Section 7 of each Course. Your child must do 2 of the 3 activities listed to complete the Course. They can begin memorizing verses in the next Course before completing the activities of the previous Course, but they cannot advance to a third Course without finishing the first Course's Activities.

What if My Child Finishes the Book Early?

Great! They can choose to go through the book a second time to earn their Review Pin Award or they can choose to do one or more different Extra Books. A list of Extra Book challenges can be provided to them at that time. They can work on the Extra Book over multiple years of club if necessary. When they complete an Extra Book they will get an additional award during the Awards Night ceremony at the end of the year.

Is My Child Required to Give To Missions Each Week?

No, it's optional; however, we will encourage clubbers to give to the missionaries throughout the year. Each year as a club we select a Missionary to support through prayer and giving. Any amount is appreciated, even a penny. All missions monies collected throughout the year go completely to the missionary.

What Do the Dues for Club Go Toward?

Club dues help cover some of the costs incurred to run the Young Navigators club. Some of these expenses include the food for food nights, store prizes, awards throughout the year, awards at the end of the year, etc. Most of the club's expenses are covered by Harvest Baptist Temple.
