## Craft Night for a Cause

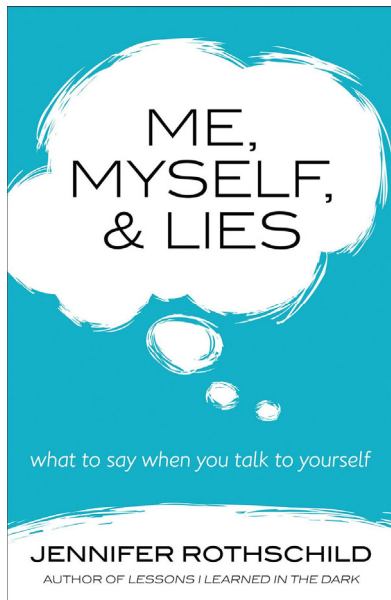
