# PRECHOOL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

## 2/3's

This class is designed for the two and three year old in his or her first school experience, learning social and listening skills through the use of manipulatives, finger plays, songs, stories, playtime, and sensory activities. Children enjoy group and individual activities. Colors, shapes, numbers and letters are introduced through art, table activities and music. They are encouraged and guided to make choices that promote confidence and age appropriate behavior while learning classroom routines.

#### 3's

This class focuses on teaching social skills, listening skills and helping children to follow directions. Academics such as letter recognition, language development, pre-writing skills, number recognition and other math skills are introduced in age-appropriate ways. This includes Bible stories, free play, art projects, finger plays, outdoor play, manipulative and dramatic play, music, and much more. Themes & concepts throughout the year include shapes, sizes, seasons, senses and community helpers, same/different, opposites, positional rhyming and sequencing. Both fine and gross motor skills will be developed as the children explore the classroom and interact with their classmates.

#### Pre-Kindergarten (PreK)/Transitional Kindergarten (TK)

For children who are 4 or 5 years old. Pre-Kindergarten (PreK)/Transitional Kindergarten (TK) is designed as a preparatory Kindergarten class. The curriculum focuses on developing pre-reading, premath and emergent writing skills. Games and hands-on activities are always incorporated to strengthen sensory and fine motor skills. There is also plenty of music, dramatic play, art and storytelling. Additionally, the students develop social skills through art projects, learning centers and creative projects.

#### Kindergarten (K)

For children who are 5 or 6 years old. Children continue to develop a wide range of skills in kindergarten, including physical, social, emotional, language and literacy, and thinking (cognitive) skills.

#### **Extended Care Options**

#### **Breakfast Club**

Available M-F from 7:00-9:00am and includes breakfast.

Offered M-F from 12:00-1:00pm - giving children additional time to socialize, play with other class-mates and then enjoy lunch together.

#### **Extended Day**

Offered M-F; with options for care available until 4:00pm or 5:00pm. Fees include the traditional preschool class program, Lunch Bunch, rest time and age appropriate activities.
