## Good Health Guidelines

We want to provide a safe and healthy environment for all children, volunteers, and staff. Therefore, we have developed this policy in compliance with the CDC guidelines. In order to maintain a healthy environment, we ask that parents adhere to the policy below when bringing their children into all Centerpoint Kids programs.

### We ask that all children:

- Have **no** fever over 99.5 for at least 24 hours without fever reducing medicine
- Be **free** from vomiting for 24 hours
- Have **no** discharge of any kind
- Have **no** open wounds
- Be **free** from diarrhea for 24 hours
- Have **no** green runny nose
- Have **no** excessive or productive coughing
- Be **free** from any questionable rash
- Be **free** from communicable disease
- Have **no** lice, including eggs or nits
- If a child is being treated with an **antibiotic**, he or she should have received treatment for 24 hours prior to attending any program

Children cannot be admitted when any of the above is observed
