## Centerpoint Kids Good Health Guidelines

We want to provide a safe and healthy environment for all children, volunteers, and staff. Therefore, we have developed this policy in compliance with the CDC guidelines. In order to maintain a healthy environment, we ask that parents adhere to the policy below when bringing their children into all Centerpoint Kids programs.

## We ask that all children:

- Have no fever over 100.4 for at least 24 hours without fever reducing medicine
- Be free from vomiting for 24 hours
- Have no discharge of any kind
- Have no open wounds
- Be free from diarrhea for 24 hours
- Have no green runny nose
- Have no excessive or productive coughing
- Be free from any questionable rash
- · Be free from communicable disease
- Have no lice, including eggs or nits
- If a child is being treated with an antibiotic, he or she should have received treatment for 24 hours prior to attending any program

Children cannot be admitted when any of the above is observed
