What are some of the ways in which Luke reshaped Isaiah’s prophecy?

3. Why do you think God chose to announce the birth of his Son to shepherds?
4. Compare the shepherds’ response of sharing what they had seen with everyone with your own personal experiences of sharing about your faith. When does it feel natural for you to talk about the Lord with those who don’t know him?
