Icebreaker:

Have you ever experienced someone describing you in a way you felt really wasn't you? (i.e., “he is always too busy” – but you don't feel that way about yourself. Or “she is not a good listener” but you feel that you are.)

Discussion Questions:

1. Was there a time in your life when you thought of Jesus as being just a religious teacher?

2. Why did C.S. Lewis say we cannot say of Jesus, “He was a great religious or spiritual teacher”?

3. Look over how Jesus is described in the scriptures:

God incarnate	Prophet	Savior
Son of God	High Priest	Light of the world
Word incarnate	King of kings

4. Have you recently gained a new insight into who Jesus is to you?

If yes, what was that?

5. Read 1 Corinthians 13:11-12.

Do you think there are limits to our knowing Jesus? If yes, what are they?

Do you think our own complacency or our being overly comfortable with what knowledge of Jesus we have can limit us?
