- Ability to lift 50+ pounds and help unload and load equipment for set up and tear down each week.
- Desire to consistently grow in the areas of media and tech and look to maximize the ministry you serve in.

You will be looking after:

- Managing all services for media and sound production under the supervision of the Senior Pastor.
- Maintaining a working knowledge (operation/assembly) of production, sound, and media equipment/systems.



- Assisting with core projects/events.
- Preparing & maintaining the campus auditorium. Ensuring equipment is clean, updated, labeled and fully functional.
- Performing and maintaining quarterly preventative maintenance for production equipment/systems.
- Managing the process of recruiting, scheduling, training, and coaching volunteers to provide production support in main service(s).
- Maintaining production supplies and storage; batteries, gaff tape, etc
