The Value of Public Worship as a Family

Bring the kids to worship this summer! Sunday School concludes on May 22nd at both campuses- we want to encourage you to bring your kids with you to worship!

Here at Bethel, we value delighting in the Lord together as families in corporate worship. As a Faith@ Home church, we believe that the primary discipling relationship is the family and that modeling is a key component of this discipling. Therefore, we hold the value that it is good for children to be with their parents in corporate worship. We know that kids have to grow into this skill-so we are committed to creating a culture where we see kids in worship as normal and good!

Here are a few of the reasons we value this:

- 1. When children are with their parents it allows them to learn from mom and dad's example- as mom and dad are listening and worshipping, children will value what they see mom and dad valuing.
- 2. Worshiping together allows the family to hear the same message. Children are amazingly able to pick up and learn much more than we can ever imagine. You will think they are not picking up what is happening, only to hear them repeat something they heard in a sermon later that week.
- 3. It encourages and invites children to be "drawn up" to the adult world rather than keeping them in a child centered world. How can we expect them to learn the language of faith if they are not hearing it?



They may not use words like righteousness, holiness, grace, repentance, belief and salvation in their normal conversation at age 5, but they can begin to hear/learn the words.

- 4. It helps them develop the art of listening to a sermon. To listen to someone else speak is an important life skill, and one that will serve our children well.
- 5. It allows our children to see other people of all ages engaged and involved in public worship. It helps them build the fabric of connections as they watch others who model what it means to worship together as a church.

It models inclusiveness.
