

What does it mean to adopt the Bigirmi People Group?

As believers in Jesus, we have been chosen... predestined...adopted as children of God! With that adoption comes an invitation to participate with Jesus in his mission to the nations. This is why we as a church have "ADOPTED" the Bagirmi people of Chad...a people who for decades and centuries have been unreached with the gospel. The Bagirmi people of Chad number around 150.000 people and have no church in the context of their language and culture. Bethel has committed to send and support missionaries to live among them and learn their language and share the gospel with them so that they too might hear and be saved; so that they too might be adopted as children of God!

Adoption means sacrifice. It takes commitment. It does not come without cost. But it is so worth it!

Since we as a church adopted the Bagirmi people in 2009, God has been working in and through our commitment.

- **1** Bagirmi children are hearing the Word of God through the Gethsemane de Meube school in Boudamasa.
- **2** Traditional story-tellers are learning the stories of Jesus and sharing them in Bagirmi communities.

- **3** The bible is being translated into the Bagirmi language, and for the first time ever, Bagirmi people are reading and hearing the Word of God in their heart language.
- 4 There is the beginning of a Bagirmi church that has sprouted.

Things are happening! Let's consider this adoption as any adoption should be considered. A commitment to see things through, so that the Bagirmi will also join with us in rejoicing over their adoption into the family of God!
