Opening Devotion and Prayer

Welcome New Board Member

The group welcomed new board member, Kim Hellenga.

The MOB will continue to meet on the 3rd Thursday of each month at 6pm and will not meet in December. Once a quarter, we will meet off-campus at a local restaurant to encourage fellowship and discussion in the community

As a church, we are striving to better connect the Preschool and Academy with the greater church. We have worked with Preschool administration to align their outreach with the Monthly Mission Focus. To add permanence and consistency to this effort, the

MOB approved a member from the Preschool and Academy staff that can act as a liaison. Sarah will discuss a potential member with Preschool administration.

Financial Update

Sarah presented status of the budget January month end as well as income and expense projections for 2022. After evaluating the submissions from our Hillside supported missionaries, the MOB voted to reallocate \$4,000 from New Mission Endeavors to the Hillside missionaries to be split between our two international missionaries as an additional offering to cover anticipated and unanticipated needs. The remainder of the additional funds (higher contributions to Missions in September and December than projected) will remain in New Mission Endeavors. Possible uses of these funds are: increasing the Hillside Serves budget or outfitting an ERT trailer. This will be evaluated as needs arise.

Missions and Outreach Update

Give a Kid a Chance 2022 – will be in-person in 2022, possibly July 9th. The leadership team from the past has stepped back, and Revolution Church is taking on the lead role. Hillside has the opportunity to take on a deeper role than in previous years.

Summer Lunch Program – still unknown if this program will be daily or weekly, which determines the push we need to make for volunteers. This decision comes from MUST and will depend on whether or not the free USDA food is extended past May 2022.

Honduras Outreach International – we have a trip scheduled! HOI has a great COVID protocol program in place, but it will still be a riskier trip. We have an initial interest

meeting scheduled for March 20th to gauge interest and answer questions of anyone interested.

Orphanage Emmanuel – still does not have a date set to open to teams

Additional updates – MUST Ministries shelter opening in the spring, Forever Fed serving 100-130 families on campus each Tuesday, Circle of Friends has next event scheduled for March 17th 6:30-8pm

Hands of Hope trip

Sam and Larry and Linda Chapman are joining a Mt. Bethel team to Hands of Hope in Welch WV. The MOB has previously approved an exploratory trip. Their projects will include working on the thrift store, food distribution, special dinner(s), and Ladies Night. Sam requested a \$1,000 donation to assist with the programs provided. The MOB approved this request.
