Habitat For Humanity

Hillside UMC partners with Habitat For Humanity's home building ministry in Cherokee County. When a new home build is going on, Hillside sends servants to work alongside the homeowners to make their dream of owning their own home come true.

Helping Hands

As needs arise in our community, a team is formed to go out to answer the call. These Helping Hands servants provide help such as yard work, light carpentry, repairs, cleaning and visitation.

Hope Center

Hillside servants partner alongside the Hope Center pregnancy education ministry. Servants are needed from serving at the thrift store to mentoring young soon to be parents. Mentors will be interviewed and trained.

HUGS

This blanket making ministry provides a warm hug to orphans, sick, and elderly. Each fleece blanket is made with loving care, gift wrapped with a poem to make sure each recipient knows they are loved and being prayed for. HUGS meets the first and third Tuesday of each month from 10:00 a.m. to noon. The summer schedule differs slightly.

Prison Ministry
