

## Summer Outreach Update

There will be changes this year to our summer ministries due to COVID 19. Ministry takes a lot of planning, especially large ministry such as Summer Lunch and Give A Kid A Change. Because of this, there are going to be some significant changes to insure our community children are being cared for in the best way possible. Below is how Hillside will be serving this summer.

- **FOREVER FED**

We are continuing to collect non-perishable foods for Forever Fed. Please donations in the metal rack outside the Forever Fed entrance at the back of the church. Follow the signs to Forever Fed.

- **SUMMER LUNCH**

MUST ministry will be purchasing complete bag lunches to be handed out to our children this summer. Each lunch will include a sandwich, drink, salty and sweet snack. The families will need to come to Hillside to receive one week's worth of lunches for each child living in their home through a drive through pick up. These meals will be handed out to the families on the same designated day each week. We will try to work with Forever Fed so families only need to make one trip to hillside to receive a food box and summer lunch foods. Volunteer opportunities for this ministry this year will be limited. There will be no summer lunch builds during the month of June. We will reevaluate for July. More information on this will become available.

- **GIVE A KID A CHANCE**

This year Give A Kid A Chance will only be giving out backpacks through a drive through pick up. They are short on filled back packs due to churches being closed and shopping being limited.

**Here is where YOU can help!**

Please consider purchasing backpacks and below listed school supplies to donate to GAKAC. Here is all you need to do:

1. Purchase a backpack (or however many you feel led to buy).
2. Decide if you are going to pack for an Elementary or Middle/High school child.
3. Fill your pack with **ALL** the supplies listed below as designated for age group.
4. On the outside of the bag, attached a piece of paper noting that this backpack is for an elementary school child or middle/high school child (easiest is to staple the paper through the top handle).
5. Pray for the child/ren that will be receiving your backpack/s.
6. Drop off at Hillside, dates and locations to be announced soon.
7. Each pack should be complete before making a donation. If you have a partially packed backpack, please note clearly with a piece of paper taped to the front of the pack. This will help us to insure each child receives a completed pack. Drop off locations will become available very soon, but start collecting now.
