ONGOING MINISTRY

We are so thankful, that in spite of some on-going political tensions, we have been able to continue ministering here in Nicaragua. Every Thursday, at a local restaurant in La Concepción we hold Bible studies where we are working through the Gospel of John. Also, on Monday's we are continuing our Bible studies/outreach at the soccer fields and are teaching through a basic understanding of the attributes of God; each week at least 15-20 young men attend. Additionally, we have been able to start meeting on Sundays! This month we have had several new people attend our Bible studies. Pray for the Holy Spirit to work in hearts as we share the Gospel!
