## Church Planting Missionaries To Native Alaska

### Transportation/Accommodations

As we continue travel abroad to visit churches to bring awareness of the spiritual need in the Alaskan Native villages, we are continually thankful for the bus that one of our supporters purchased for us to convert to a motor home. Flood rains plaguing the east coast and snowy conditions in the northwest has forced us to change meetings around, and made it difficult to chip away at the project of making the bus more livable while presenting the work to churches. However the Lord has blessed through all these things and has placed us in the churches he wanted us for support.

### Radio Station/KLIU

One such church has a radio ministry and because the Lord directed us to them for such a time as this they are giving us a new 100ft tower for the radio station that they invested over \$8,500 in engineering. As it turns out the zoning wouldn't allow them to use the tower but it fits our needs and specifications exactly.

### Church Building/Outreach

We have lost much of our coverage we had scheduled in Unalakleet while out on our deputation furlough, which puts us in a bit of a predicament financially. However it appears the Lord has much for us to do that we need to be in Unalakleet for this summer. Although we were only able to raise a small amount in proportion to continue what we need to labor unimpeded by finances, the Lord has provided most if not all what we need to break ground

and complete the foundation for the new church, home, training center, outreach on the hill. We are working right now with some suppliers, fellow saints, and even some individuals in Unalakleet that have volunteered their services and equipment.

### In Conclusion/Prayer Request

Since this letter is a bit over due I am going to cut it off and conclude with some special prayer request.

- We are going to need to return for an indeterminate amount of time to raise support since we had to cut this time short. Please pray for wisdom and sufficient coverage.
- Coverage for a few weeks in Unalakleet while we travel in the States.
- A building program is something out of my comfort zone. Please pray for continued provision and direction.
- Please pray for a flatbed semi driver, & finances to transport the radio tower from NC to the port in Seattle by May 10th.
- Someone that would consider finishing the bus for us while we return to the field.
- Finances for summer outreaches such as the 4th of July feeding, summer VBS in Unalakleet and other villages.
