Summary:

Our church has been blessed with many, many children! As a church family, we want to build lasting relationships across generations and raise up children to know and love Jesus. You can help out in any capacity, whether it's simply getting kids checked in on our computer system in the morning, assisting in a classroom, or leading as a teacher. We provide the curriculum, supplies, and training. We have something for every experience level, so if you love children and want to serve this important part of our church, SeasideKids ministry is for you!

Commitment:

- One Sunday per month. Positions are also available for substitutes (as needed) and fifth Sunday volunteers (4 times/year).
- Arrive at Seaside no later than 15 minutes before your scheduled service. Stay until the last kid is picked up (usually 5 - 10 minutes before the end of the service).
- If lead teaching, prepare/review lesson in advance, notify SeasideKids directors if any supplies are needed.

Needed Positions:

- **Toddler room (1 - 3 year olds):** no curriculum, just playing with little ones.
- **4 year-old - Kindergarten class:** curriculum and supplies provided, lead teachers and assistant teachers (can be as involved in planning as you want, or simply show up and help) needed.
- **1st - 3rd grade class:** curriculum and supplies provided, lead and assistant teachers needed.
- **4th and 5th grade class:** curriculum and supplies provided, lead and assistant teachers needed.
- **Check-in:** arrive at church 20 minutes before service, check in and print name tags for all teachers and children, remain upstairs throughout the service to provide front-door security and get parents if kids are crying.

Experience:

- Experience working with children is always a plus, but not necessary. We will provide all the training and pair you with someone more experienced if necessary.
