



HMUMC MMO & Preschool Decision Tree:

Direct Exposure/Close Contact

Any individual who has been within six (6) feet for a cumulative total of fifteen (15) minutes or more over a 24-hour period, with or without a mask, of someone who is confirmed COVID-19 positive or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

Exposure & Return to School

The following return-to-school conditions apply for any child or staff member who suspects that they have been directly exposed.

Fully Vaccinated

In general, people are considered fully vaccinated:

- 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, OR
- 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine

The Situation	When Staff/Student May Return
Person is Fully Vaccinated	Immediate Return AND monitor symptoms AND wear masks for 10 days
Person is Unvaccinated Close Contact	At least 10 days from last exposure AND has no symptoms AND wears a mask at least 14 days from last exposure
Asymptomatic Person with Laboratory-Confirmed COVID-19	At least 10 days have passed since the positive laboratory test AND the person remains asymptomatic
Symptomatic Person with Laboratory-Confirmed COVID-19	At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared if mild or moderate illness AND At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications AND Symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath) have improved
