

Hourly Distribution Worker

The Pantry at Hamilton Mill United Methodist Church is a growing Food Pantry in North East Georgia that seeks to address food insecurity in our area. Since 2009, The Pantry has rapidly grown from feeding 25 families a month to providing a week's worth of food for well over 2,500 families a month. In 2021, The Pantry distributed more than one million pounds of food to our community. Our vision is to bring our community to the table of faith by taking hunger off the table.

As The Pantry continues to grow, we are hiring an hourly Distribution Worker to help maintain the distribution efforts of our organization. This position will work with our Distribution Coordinators to assist with delivery intake, shelving, and food transport. Additionally, the position will sometimes be asked to drive our 16ft Box Delivery Truck to designated pick up locations, being able to independently load and offload pallets. The work will involve a variety of tasks that require a great deal of manual labor.

What You Need to Succeed

- be at least 21 years old
- be available to work:
 - Wednesdays 9am to 1pm
 - Fridays 9am to 1pm
 - Occasional Saturday mornings on an as needed basis
- pass a background check, driver screening check, onsite driving test of our 16ft Box Truck, and eventual onsite driving test of stand-up forklift
- lift, carry and stack product weighing:
 - 67 pounds for Frozen Foods and Produce
 - 85 pounds for Boxed Meat/Dairy
- stand, bend, stoop and twist and do repetitive work for long periods of time
- work quickly and with flexibility for changing needs throughout the week
- interpret, understand and follow instructions
- maintain a pleasant demeanor and work well with a variety of people of different backgrounds and ages
