## VBS Reimagined - ANCHORED Frequently Asked Questions

- Registration
  - Each camper must register online via <a href="http://www.hmumc.org/vbs-reimagined">http://www.hmumc.org/vbs-reimagined</a>.
  - Great for all ages PreK to 5th.
  - 6th grade program available.
  - Adults who choose to host others should share registration link so that each child is registered. See "Host" info tab.
- 2. What will the schedule be?
  - Any 2 days for approximately 2.5 hours each during the week of July 13.
    - Video (Bible story fun)
    - Games
    - Crafts
    - Wrap up: Devotion and Prayer
- 3. What is online?
  - Access via VBS page on HMUMC website
  - Bible story and worship videos (pre-recorded)
  - Digital downloads of worship songs.
  - How-to videos for both games and crafts
    - Simple tutorial videos to be viewed by adults in advance that will explain games and crafts. Our games team will record how to play each game. Crafts team will provide a step by step video with finished example. Written instructions and pictures will be included in each kit.
- Zoom small group time with Pastor Natalee and Mrs. Traci in the evening (times and days TBD)
- 4. Can I do this in my yard or cul-de-sac?
  - This experience is very flexible and easy! Everything can be done outside or inside, except for games...unless you want a very wet living room!
  - Video can be viewed on any device, outside or inside.
  - VBS music provided via mp3 and easily downloaded to your device. We recommend
    playing music during craft and games time to add excitement. A bluetooth speaker or
    straight out of your personal device.
- 5. What is in a kit and when/where can I pick one up?
  - Each registered child receives their own kit.
  - Anchored VBS Reimagined handbook
  - T-shirt for camper
  - 2 snacks (1 per day)
  - Craft and game supplies (games can be adapted for a few or multiple players)
  - Pick up at the church, schedule coming soon.
