SPIRITUALLY

- Have a continual, growing relationship with Jesus.

- Pre-watch the Bible Study and have material prepared for classes.
- Do your best at being at every meeting and when you can't, determine if you have someone fill in as a leader or if the meeting should be changed or postponed instead.
- Communicate and work with the Grow Staff on a consistent basis.
