

This annual report provides a glimpse of the strategic vision God has given the leadership of GlobeServe for the next five years and numerous highlights from 2021.




A key method of success that GlobeServe uses in reaching people with the Gospel is our willingness to meet people where that are at. Paul talks about this approach in 1 Corinthians 9-10. We feel compelled to take the church to where it is not. We don't cloister ourselves and win people by being separate from them. Instead, we engage with the people in each community and become involved in their lives, their struggles, and successes. Through our <u>Social Mandates</u> we provide access to basic needs such as safe water, malaria prevention, deworming, food, clothing, education, and vocational training where needed. This approach then provides an opportunity to implement our <u>Evangelism Mandate</u> where we can share the everlasting love of Jesus Christ and grow Disciples of Christ in communities previously hostile to "Church Planters" who come and go.

GlobeServe follows a Process of Engagement to equip Missionaries and Pastors for successful disciple making in every community we are called to serve.

PROCESS OF ENGAGEMENT



The **Select, Train and Place** Process of Engagement is a commitment on the part of GlobeServe and those called to be Missionaries and Pastors. It is a commitment within each community to make disciples and form a community even before a church building is constructed. Once started, that church then commits to plant five more churches and the process continues to multiply just like the process described in the book of Acts. A portion of our strategic vison for the next five years is described below.



GlobeServe uses a Movement Missionary Church Planter (MMCP) strategy to equip each Missionary Church Planter to disciple five churches who then start 5 churches. With 25 MMCP's in 2022 the multiplication impact is amazing and reminds us of the story found in John 6:1-14.

2021 Operational Highlights

Included in this report is a summary of how God has used GlobeServe in 2021 to further the building of the kingdom of God for the future. 2021 saw several new areas of ministry and the near completion of a hostel for visiting Missionaries and Pastors while in training at the African Center for Missions in Tamale, Ghana.

Pastor Samuel Anthony Kofi Dunya (Pastor Sam) is the founder and leader of GlobeServe Ministries in West Africa. His role is to provide vision and oversight to the church and to also assure the theological and doctrinal soundness of all teaching. He is highly engaged in all aspects of the ministry. If he is not dedicating a new well in a community, he may be speaking at a GlobeServe Justice Conference on Anti-Child Trafficking and Slavery or preaching at a GlobeServe Youth Leadership Conference in Tamale, or helping to launch GlobeServe Youth Ministries in Burkina Faso, or teaching Pastors at the GlobeServe Bible School and Seminary, or meeting with Muslim Chiefs about needs in their communities. And the list goes on. Looking for Pastor Sam is like the game, "Where's Waldo". Oh yeah, he is also a full-time pastor! The team Pastor Sam has been blessed to lead is amazing. His wife and life partner in ministry, Johnhild Dunya, is God sent. This year also saw additional support and involvement in the ministry from Samuel Dunya Jr. and help from their daughter, Suzi, launching the updated GlobeServe website.




TESTIMONY FROM BURKINA FASO



Under the IRS Articles of Incorporation, Article VII says the GlobeServe Board was established to ensure "No part of the net earnings of GlobeServe International shall inure to benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay only reasonable out of pocket expenses...."

<u>Article III – Purpose</u> says "GlobeServe International is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, which qualifies as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The primary purpose of GlobeServe International is to expand the Christian Church through teaching and preaching of the Gospel to both adults and children, and by also providing charitable humanitarian aid for the poor."
