## WEEK 3

EASTER MEANS YOU'RE NEVER ALONE.

---

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a **living hope** through the **resurrection of Jesus Christ** from the dead.

1 PETER 1:3 NIV

Now ask yourself, is there something in my life leaving me feeling hopeless? Bring that to God right now! **Ask Him for hope when you feel hopeless. Ask Him to show you today that He is still alive and at work in your life.**
