NOTES

This process is for potential long-term workers (over 2 years commitment).

This is for people who call Nona their *sending* church, not just a supporting church.

Nona Church should coordinate with sending agencies in regards to their requirements.

For sending agencies that don't require a sending church, this process could be "recommended" training.

Each **Knowledge** component requires a 1-page reflective journal entry from the participant.
