Director of Youth and Media

Description:

The Director of Youth & Media is responsible for overseeing the youth ministry, as well as the media presence of the church. The ideal candidate will have a clear testimony concerning their faith in Jesus, will display excellent leadership and relational skills, and will support the church's mission and goals. Additionally, they will have a passion for next generation ministries, and savviness relating to the world of social media.

Youth Responsibilities:

1. Taylor the church mission statement for application to the next generation.
 - Thoughtfully consider the implications of the peace of Christ for teenagers today, and design ministry accordingly.
 - Develop a core curriculum and strategy for implementation along the church mission sub-statements (Home, Church, Marketplace, City).
2. Develop and lead programs according to the vision and purpose of the youth ministry.
 - Create outreach programs, activities and events.
 - Plan spiritual growth programs, activities and events that include opportunities for teenagers to worship, fellowship with each other, learn Biblical truths and apply them to their lives.
3. Recruit and train volunteer leaders to help you with your purpose.
 - Every teenager should know at least one adult who is praying, caring and investing in their lives.
 - Meet regularly with your volunteers.
 - Provide annual training events or conferences for your team.
4. Build and maintain relationships with teenagers both church and unchurched.
 - Meet regularly with teenagers from the youth group and their friends.
 - Develop friendships with the families of teenagers in and outside the church.
5. Build and maintain quality relationships with parents.
 - Clearly share the mission of the youth ministry with parents so they understand the purpose of the youth ministry, and how they can participate in that mission in the home.
 - Create avenues of consistent contact with parents (regular e-newsletters, annual parent meetings, etc.).
 - Become aware of the needs of the parents.
6. Network with other youth workers in the diocese and deanery.
 - Initiate contact with other youth workers for networking and prayer.
 - Program or attend diocesan/deanery events with other youth ministries annually.

7. Set and oversee the youth ministry budget.
 - Working with the finance committee and the Senior Pastor, set a budget that reflects the mission of the church.
 - Be prudent with finances, sticking with the budget you set.
 - Creatively design fundraisers to offset budget needs.
8. Involve teenagers in the ministry of the church as a whole, supporting and participating in the church's mission, worship services, and activities.
9. Attend staff meetings and meet regularly with the Senior Pastor to go over ideas, goals, issues, etc.
10. Other duties as assigned.

Media Responsibilities

1. Promote Prince of Peace and its mission through various forms of social media, marketing and communications.
2. Increase the reach and influence of the church in the community through social media connections and engagement.
3. Schedule regular posts of content for engagement.
4. Evaluate and report data related to social media engagement.

This is a full-time exempt position that includes health insurance, vacation, and retirement contribution.
