Hebrews 12:2 – *“And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, ²fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.”*

ANNIE ARMSTRONG EASTER OFFERING (AAEO) - MARCH-MAY

This special offering is the primary way we support mission efforts in North America. 100% of gifts given are used to support Southern Baptist missionaries serving across the United States and Canada. The offering was started in 1895 by the Woman's Missionary Union (WMU) to benefit the work of the Home Mission Board (now the North American Mission Board). In 1934 it was named in honor of Annie Armstrong, a bold missions advocate and WMU's first national executive leader. Today, more than \$1 billion has been donated by Southern Baptist churches and individuals.
