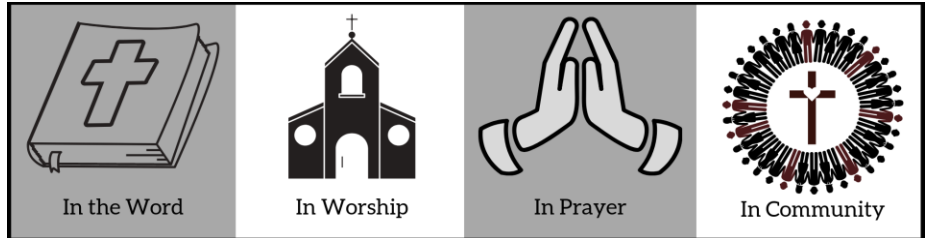

If you're considering Meals-on-Wheels delivery to your home, pamphlets are available in the narthex or contact Kathy Bichel (320-5864).

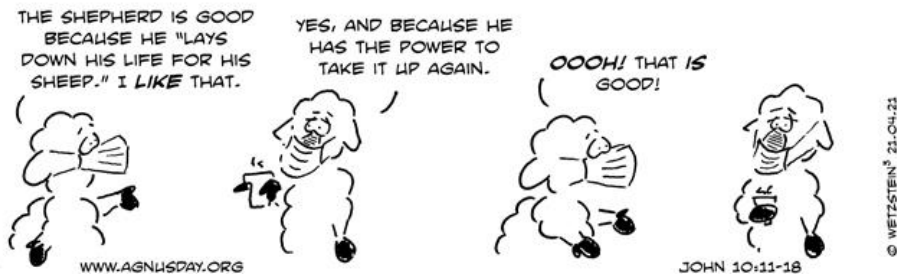
