#### **Confession and Absolution**

- E Standing in the presence of Almighty God we are aware of His great blessings in our lives. Yet, we often forget to live our lives in thankfulness to Him. Let us confess our sins to God seeking His forgiveness.
- Lord Jesus, we confess to You our sins. We have no excuses. We have sinned against You and each other by our failure to love You and each other as You have loved us. You have blessed our lives and so often we have been ungrateful. You have blessed us physically, emotionally, and spiritually. In turn we have failed to be a blessing to others or to bless Your holy name. For our sinfulness and our lack of thankfulness for all Your blessings, we deserve Your punishment. We are sorry for our sins and ask You to forgive us and enable us to live our lives in thankfulness to You.
- P Jesus knows your sinfulness and yet, He still loves you. He has borne your sins in His body on the cross. Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God to you and, in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the 

  Son and of the Holy Spirit. "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well." (*Luke 17:19*)

Deuteronomy 8:1–10

"The whole commandment that I command you today you shall be careful to do, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land that the LORD swore to give to your fathers. And you shall remember the whole way that the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments or not. And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD. Your clothing did not wear out on you and your foot did not swell these forty years. Know then in your heart that, as a man disciplines his son, the LORD your God disciplines you. Luke 17:11–19


- The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the seventeenth chapter.

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.


And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord,


### Offering
