### Volunteer Description

- Ensure general safety and wellbeing of children in the class (this includes any COVID precautions). Alert parents (or responsible adults) if their presence is necessary. Direct/re-direct children toward safer and more respectful behavior and actions, as is necessary
- Start/stop the worship song video and Bible Story video. (\*Videos and projector are prepared ahead of time by the Children's Ministry Director (CMD).\*)
- Lead children in discussion of the Bible story, by asking a few questions related to the story. (\*Questions are planned ahead of time by CMD.\*)
- Lead game/activity that is related to the Bible story. Follow written instructions for game/activity and tell/show kids how to play the game or do the activity. (\*Game or activity including materials and instructions is planned ahead of time by CMD.\*)
- Lead craft that is related to the Bible story. Follow written instructions for the craft and tell/ show kids how to make the craft. (\*Craft - including materials - is planned ahead of time by CMD.\*)
- Ensure that each child is picked up by their parent (or responsible adult) and checked out
