Hello from Taiwan, hope this letter finds you well. As I reflect on these last few months, I can honestly say they have been some of the toughest since first arriving in Taiwan. For those who have been praying for us, thank you so much! Though the enemy is trying to derail us, this season is allowing David and I to go deeper in Him than we ever have before.

You know what's really cool too? Even in the dark night of the soul, God continues to move, because He loves people that much.

This last weekend was Easter Sunday, and we celebrated the new life of one of our students from the Normal University Ministry. Cai-Qi has been attending our club for the last year. Several months ago, she went on our "Experience God" weekend retreat, and since then has done one on one discipleship classes with a local church leader. She made the decision on Easter Sunday to be baptized in water.
